Her critically-acclaimed short fiction collections include *American Salvage*, which was a finalist for both the National Book Award and the National Book Critic's Circle Award; *Women and Other Animals*, which won the AWP prize for short fiction; , and *Mothers, Tell Your Daughters* (Autumn 2015). Her story "The Smallest Man in the World" was awarded a Pushcart Prize and her story "The Inventor, 1972" was awarded the 2009 Eudora Welty Prize from *Southern Review*. She was a 2011 Guggenheim Fellow.
