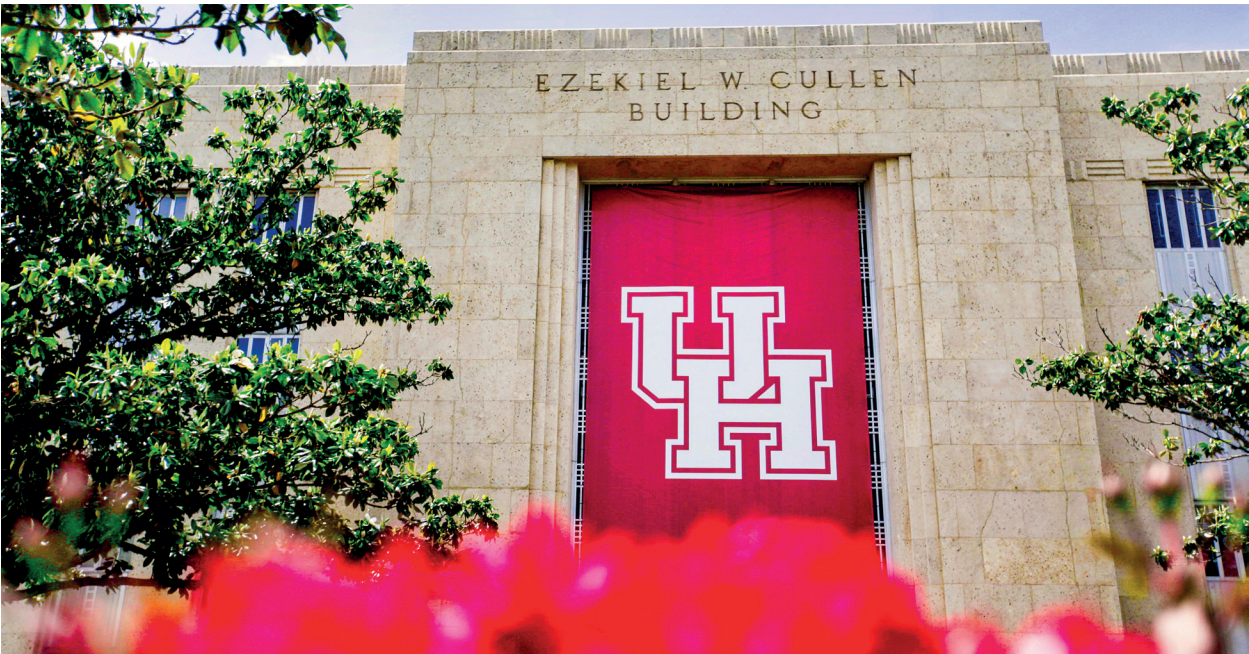

University of Houston History



The University of Houston was established as the Houston Junior College in 1927. As the college grew, it prospered and officially became the four-year University of Houston in 1934. Two years later, the college attained land for a permanent campus, and in 1939 it constructed its first building, the Roy G. Cullen Building. The University became a state institution in 1963.

The University includes 14 academic colleges, one school and a multidisciplinary Honors College, collectively teaching a wide array of subjects – from math, arts and engineering to law, pharmacy and business. What started as a campus with a single building has grown into a world-class university, offering over 285 undergraduate and graduate programs to more than 46,000 students annually.

The Cougars consistently compete at the highest levels, earning conference championships, bowl game invitations and NCAA Final Four appearances. In 2023, UH joined the Big 12 Conference — a hard-fought mission to join a Power Four conference.

UH is a Carnegie-designated Tier One public research university, and its public service and

community activities, such as cultural offerings, clinical services, policy studies and small business initiatives, serve a diverse metropolitan population. Likewise, the resources of the Gulf Coast Region complement and enrich the University’s academic programs, providing students with professional expertise, practical experience and career opportunities. This unprecedented success has been followed by a string of similar achievements, being awarded a Phi Beta Kappa honor society chapter, the opening of Houston’s first medical school in nearly 50 years, more than tripling the number of National Academy members on the faculty and dramatically improving the graduation rates.

The University consistently earns accolades for its students’ achievements, such as the top 50 of Forbes’ list of America’s Top Colleges and Princeton Review’s “50 Best Value Public Colleges.” It also ranks 36th in the nation on U.S. News & World Report’s 2025 social mobility index ranking and among the top 100 universities in the world for utility patents. Moreover, President Renu Khator is boldly leading UH to become a U.S. News & World Report top 50 public university.

Commencement Traditions

Academic costumes of today have a history of nearly eight centuries. In medieval Europe, all townspeople wore long flowing robes and gowns. The materials and colors were governed by royal decree. Gradually, distinctive gowns were developed for the various professions, trades and guilds. Scholars wore robes and hoods to protect their shaved heads. Later, skullcaps were worn on the head, and the hoods became a cape that could be pulled over the head during unpleasant weather.

As additional universities were founded, distinctive forms of the gown and hood were adapted by their faculties for bachelor's (apprentices of the arts), master's (teachers) and doctoral (teachers who had completed postgraduate studies). When caps and hats came into fashion in the 15th century, the hoods became ornamental, draped over the shoulders and down the back.

The academic hat was first worn as a symbol of the master's degree and existed in various forms. The mortarboard style comes to us from Oxford University. When academic costumes came to America in 1754, styles were quite varied. In Europe, they still are; however, in our country, usage has been standardized by the Intercollegiate Code of Academic Costume.

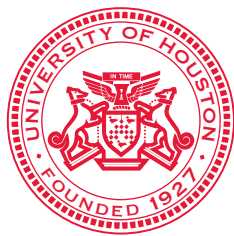

THE SEAL

Throughout history, seals have been used to authenticate official documents. The University of Houston and UH System seals both bear the Official Seal of Arms of General Sam Houston, as handed down to him from his noble ancestors. It includes the escutcheon in the center of the seal — consisting of checkered chevrons denoting nobility — and three martlets, gentle lowland birds that symbolize peace and deliverance. A winged hourglass is placed above the shield. Surmounting this is the motto “In Tempore,” meaning “In Time.” The greyhounds indicate speed of giving aid. The UH seal was first adopted in 1938 as the present campus was established. Although the look of the seal has evolved over the years, the first version was etched into the floor of the Roy G. Cullen Building.



UNIVERSITY MACE

The University Mace, which is carried in academic processions, is a staff symbolizing the University’s authority and unity. The tradition of the academic mace began in the late 14th century when two ancient instruments, the royal scepter and the battle mace, were combined to form a university president’s symbol of authority.

Honorary Degree

TILMAN J. FERTITTA

A revered entrepreneur, philanthropist and civic leader, Tilman J. Fertitta is U.S. Ambassador to Italy and San Marino and former chairman of the University of Houston System Board of Regents. Born in Galveston, Texas, Fertitta lived in Houston for most of his life, where he grew a small restaurant company into a multi-industry, billion-dollar enterprise. He is the sole owner of Fertitta Entertainment, which owns restaurant giant Landry’s, the Golden Nugget Hotel and Casinos, and the NBA’s Houston Rockets, among other ventures.

A savvy businessman, Fertitta is a self-made billionaire who has shared his knowledge with other entrepreneurs through his New York Times best-selling book, “Shut up and Listen!” and CNBC’s “Billion Dollar Buyer” TV series. He has received numerous honors, including Ernst & Young’s Entrepreneur of the Year Award, induction into the Texas Business Hall of Fame as the second youngest inductee, Amusement Today’s Person of the Year and Casino Journal’s Executive of the Year, among others.

Fertitta is committed to giving back to his community, having served on several nonprofit boards and committees, including the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, the Greater Houston Partnership, the Texas Heart Institute, and as chairman of the Houston Children’s Charity and the Houston Police Foundation.

A champion of higher education, he served on the UH System Board of Regents for over 15 years, and as its chairman from 2014 until 2025. His strategic leadership and relentless advocacy elevated the University of Houston to top-tier status in research, academic rankings and athletics, earning it prestigious recognition in Forbes’ America’s Top Colleges rankings, the Princeton Review’s “50 Best Value Public Colleges” and membership in the Big 12 Conference.

A prolific philanthropist, in 2016, he donated \$20 million to renovate the University of Houston’s basketball arena — the largest individual donation ever made to UH Athletics at that time. In 2022, he donated \$50 million to UH’s College of Medicine, which aims to improve health outcomes in the city and state’s underserved communities — a mission Fertitta deeply values. In recognition of this incredible generosity, the basketball arena and the College of Medicine both bear the Fertitta name.

The Doctor of Humane Letters degrees, *honoris causa*, given for exemplary service to the University of Houston or society at large, is the highest honor UH can bestow.

CYNTHIA AND GEORGE MITCHELL FOUNDATION

The Cynthia and George Mitchell Foundation seeks innovative, sustainable solutions at the nexus of environmental protection, economic vibrancy, and human well-being. Since its incorporation in 1978, the late George P. Mitchell and Cynthia Woods Mitchell, and the foundation have distributed or pledged an estimated \$800 million in grants to myriad causes, programs and institutions.

Since 1994, CGMF has given more than \$21 million to the University of Houston, with most of the funding generously supporting the arts. The foundation’s interest in the arts is rooted in the sensibilities of Cynthia Woods Mitchell, who came to Houston in 1939 to study literature, art, and psychology at UH. Cynthia believed in the arts’ capacity to lift spirits, enhance intellect, broaden perspectives, and open avenues in people’s lives.

In honor of Cynthia, in 2003, George pledged \$20 million to support UH’s arts programs. Working closely with UH leadership, the Mitchell family proposed a programmatic alliance among the School of Arts, Moores School of Music, the School of Theatre & Dance, the Creative Writing Program and Blaffer Art Museum. The Cynthia Woods Mitchell Center for the Arts was born and is now thriving within UH’s Kathrine G. McGovern College of the Arts.

Today, the center fosters bold collaboration across disciplines, inspires innovation, and fuels creative partnerships on campus and across Houston’s creative landscape. Each year, funding supports various initiatives such as grants for faculty research and creative activity, student scholarships, a visiting artists program and residencies for post-graduate fellows.

Since 2019, CGMF has also provided over \$200,000 in support to the Immanuel and Helen Olshan Texas Music Festival at UH, which brings together musicians from around the world to learn, collaborate, and perform classical music.

Equally committed to advancing the sciences, in June 2025, CGMF made a \$1.1 million gift to UH’s Cullen College of Engineering for life-changing research on Usher Syndrome — a genetic disorder that can lead to deafness and blindness in children. The transformative gift will help accelerate treatments to improve vision and hearing for thousands.

MEMORIAL HERMANN HEALTH SYSTEM

Memorial Hermann Health System is one of the largest nonprofit health systems in Southeast Texas, delivering value-driven care through 17 hospitals and numerous specialty programs and services across Greater Houston. The award-winning system is home to one of the country’s busiest level 1 trauma hospitals and TIRR Memorial Hermann — one of the top three rehabilitation hospitals in the nation.

As Houston’s only community-owned health system, Memorial Hermann provides care that extends beyond its hospital walls. Each year, it contributes more than \$474 million through school-based health centers and various community health programs. In recognition of its leadership in community engagement, Memorial Hermann was awarded the American Hospital Association’s Foster G. McGaw Prize for Excellence in Community Service in 2023.

For nearly three decades, Memorial Hermann has been a steadfast partner of the University of Houston, and the official health care provider for UH Athletics. Its philanthropic support and alliance have played a vital role in advancing the University’s mission. In 1998 and again in 2006, Memorial Hermann’s contributions aided the expansion of UH’s Sugar Land campus, strengthening the region’s educational offerings. In 2019, it established a scholarship for Human Resource Development majors at the Cullen College of Engineering, helping remove financial barriers to obtaining a degree.

In 2023, UH Athletics and Memorial Hermann launched a new chapter with the health system’s transformative pledge for the University’s planned state-of-the-art Football Operations Center. The pledge also included scholarships for student-athletes. In honor of its support, the center was named the Memorial Hermann Football Operations Center, which opened in fall 2025. The 160,000-square-foot facility features a cutting-edge sports performance center, an academic support services suite, a dynamic locker room facility, student-athlete flex space and more. Elevating the fan experience, it also provides additional premium seating options to TDECU Stadium with 14 suites, a 450-seat club section with access to an 11,000 square-foot club and a 300-seat roof terrace.

A dedicated community leader, Memorial Hermann’s generosity has elevated Houston Football in the Big 12 Conference and made students’ higher education dreams a reality.

University Honors and University Honors with Honors in Major

Students who complete the Honors College curriculum (36 hours) graduate with University Honors. If students also complete a senior honors thesis, they graduate with University Honors with Honors in Major.

Collegiate Honors and Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major

Students who fulfill the requirements for the honors program in the college of their major, including 21 hours of honors courses; who complete an Honors College minor, or who complete 21 hours of approved honors courses. If students also complete a senior honors thesis, they graduate with Collegiate Honors with Honors in Major.

Membership in The Honors College and Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major

Students who affiliate with the Honors College during their undergraduate years and complete fewer than 21 hours of honors courses. If students also complete a senior honors thesis and fulfill the requirements of their major with distinction, they graduate with Membership in The Honors College with Honors in Major.
