### MASTER OF MUSIC IN CONDUCTING

**PURPOSE:** To provide advanced training and performance experience for students pursuing a career in conducting.

**MINIMUM ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Bachelor's degree in music (preferably in applied music).
2. Minimum GPA of 3.00 for last 60 semester hours and 3.00 for all music hours.
3. Submission of TOEFL or IELTS scores (as applicable) that meet University of Houston minimum standards.
4. Full senior recital in the undergraduate degree program.
5. Beginning graduate-level conducting ability as determined in an audition before members of the graduate faculty.
